Premier's Reading Challenge 2021

Once again all students at Wallsend P.S. are encouraged to have a go at the Premier's Reading Challenge (PRC). As parents this is a fantastic opportunity to encourage and develop your child's reading. The PRC books in our Library are identified with a PRC sticker to make it easier for students to locate and borrow each week. Students have till 20 August to read and enter their books.



For K-2 classes, teachers will be reading PRC books in Library and the classroom, keeping a log and entering the 30 books for each child.

Parents can also support at home if they wish.

For Yr 3-6 classes, students will be completing the Challenge independently. Students have a reading log of their own in the Library and are encouraged to read <u>one book a week-talk</u> about the book/characters/favourite part and get it signed off. Students are required to enter their 20 books online. Lessons in Library will show students how to enter their books through their Student Portal.
